As a Pharmacy Technician, you will perform administrative and clinical tasks to support pharmacies from patient interaction to working with the pharmacists. Pharmacy Technicians assist licensed pharmacists in measuring, mixing, counting, labeling, and recording the correct dosages of prescription medications. They may receive and verify prescriptions or refill requests from patients and doctors' offices. Other job responsibilities include verifying inventory, processing medical insurance forms, and operating cash registers to accept payments from customers.

The U.S. Bureau of Labor Statistics ranks Pharmacy Technicians among the fastest growing occupations over the 2016-2026 decade. Employment is projected to grow 12% – much faster than the average job ranking. As of 2016, Pharmacy Technicians held about 402,500 jobs with career opportunities in the following pharmaceutical categories: retail, hospitals, community, laboratory, compounding and nuclear.
