If you have graduated from an approved Vocational Nursing program and want to strengthen your career in the nursing field, High Desert Medical College now offers a Vocational Nursing Associate of Applied Science Degree (VNAAS) program. A Vocational Nursing Associate of Applied Science degree builds on the Vocational Nursing diploma by adding General Education and science courses, which are offered online, and these General Education and science courses are needed to enter a Registered Nursing Program.

The goal of this post-licensure program is to help Vocational Nurses become more well-rounded professionals. Graduates will benefit from enhanced critical thinking, greater scientific knowledge, and quality verbal/written communication skills. A VNAAS degree can also open new doors, as some employers will only consider applicants with an associate degree.

Total VNAAS Program Length:

52 weeks VN/48 weeks AAS = 100 weeks

Total Clock Hours: 2,204 (classroom: 1,159 + virtual and skills lab: 301 + externship: 744)

AAS Only Program Length:

3 terms/16 weeks each

Total Clock Hours: 525 (classroom: 435 + virtual and skills lab: 90)
