As a Licensed Vocational Nurse (LVN), you will be part of a health care delivery team, providing basic nursing care, administering medications, health assessment, documenting a patient's signs and symptoms as well as carrying out therapeutic and rehabilitative measures. LVNs care for people who are sick injured, convalescent, or disabled under the support direction of physicians and registered nurses.

According to the U.S. Bureau of Labor Statistics*, overall employment of licensed vocational nurses is projected to grow 6% from 2020 to 2030.
