8-Unit (8 Hours) Infection Control CE Course for DDS, RDH, RDA/RDAEF/OAP License Renewals

SUMMARY

The Infection Control CE Course fulfills the California Dental Board requirements for RDA licenser. This is not for RDA licensure renewal. An 8 hour Infection Control Course is required for all new RDA applicants. This course covers the definition and implementation of sterilization methods and guidelines. Including patient medical history, infection control, prevention of contamination, and the use of personal protective equipment. In addition, verification of infection, disinfection, care of treatment room, handling and disposal of hazardous waste, handling soiled instruments, hand pieces, burs, water and air syringes are presented.

This course has been developed in accordance with the California Code of Regulations Section 1005 to provide the most current information on infection control practices and principles and is approved by the Dental Board of California for 8 Units.

This course requires a valid CPR card by either, only, American Heart Association BLS or Red Cross BLS. If you already have a valid CPR, bring in a prepared copy of the card when you attend class.
