As a Dental Assistant, you will perform administrative and clinical tasks to support dental offices. Tasks include interacting with patients, assisting the dentist or hygienist during exams and treatments, delivering X-rays and taking dental impressions and fabricating molds or crowns.

According to the U.S. Bureau of Labor Statistics*, overall employment of dental assistants is projected to grow 8% from 2021 to 2031, faster than the average for all occupations.
