

VOCATIONAL NURSING PRE-REQUISITE (PRQ)



ONLINE COURSE - ONLY 4 WEEKS

If you are interested in the Vocational Nursing program, all students are required to complete the Vocational Nursing Pre-Requisite courses in advance of admissions. It only takes 4 weeks and is completely online.

Description

This course is a Pre-Requisite requirement for admissions into the Vocational Nursing Program. The intended audience are high school graduates that are interested in enrolling in the Vocational Nursing program.

The course introduces the nursing student to critical thinking, basic arithmetic and medication dosage calculation and normal anatomy and physiology, the interrelationships between structure and functions of human cells, tissues, and systems, and the effects of disease on body systems and basic medical terminology as well as study techniques and strategies to ensure student success throughout the program. This course will be delivered online and involve lectures and reading assignments. The student will undergo daily exams. The student will be required to participate in class discussions and take notes. Students must successfully pass this course with a 75% or higher. A certificate of completion for the course will be awarded to those who pass the course.

Accreditation & Approval

The PRQ course is approved by the Bureau of Private Postsecondary Education in California (BPPE) and accredited by the Accrediting Council for Continuing Education (ACCET).
